PLANNING AHEAD CAN REDUCE STRESS

Expect slower cell, internet service, possible issues with debit/credit cards.

Grocery shopping early will allow stores time to restock, while you avoid crowds.

Schedule appts. before or after the eclipses.

ANTICIPATE LOCAL IMPACTS

There will be extra traffic - especially on the day of both eclipses.

Expect longer lines at gas stations, retail stores and restaurants

Postpone lawn watering to reduce pressure on public water systems.

PUBLIC HEALTH REMINDERS

Have proper eye protection when viewing the eclipse!

A food license is required if you plan to sell food from your home or business.
